Members of HUMBSAR will find the work extremely rewarding, but equally arduous and challenging, so we ask you to carefully read the following before applying to join the team.

HUMBSAR is an entirely voluntary lowland search and rescue organisation providing vital search and rescue services to Humberside Police and its partner agencies. This unique team is fully funded and supported by a local community interest company, HFR Solutions, emergency response and workplace safety specialists – teaching others to Plan, Prepare and Respond in the event of an emergency. HFR Solutions' aim is to make the Humber Region a safer place to live and work.

It is the HUMBSAR aim to provide this life saving service to the Humber region, 24/7, 365 days a year, in partnership with HFR Solutions. We aim to provide a first-class professional Search and Rescue service, whenever and wherever called upon. This can only be achieved through the enthusiasm and commitment of our volunteers, their dedication to the training, exercises and operational requirements.

Volunteers will be trained to National Policing Search standards and conform to the National Police Concept of Operations, regarding Search and Rescue techniques and minimum standards. Volunteers may also be trained in other essential disciplines:

- First Aid & Advance Casualty Care
- Radio Communications
- Water Bank & Swift Water Rescue
- Working at Heights & Confined Space

HUMBSAR will be mobilised by Humberside Police and called to assist the search for vulnerable missing persons, such as children and elderly, individuals suffering from dementia, Alzheimer's, mental health issues, or those with learning disabilities. These individuals are often considered unable to care for themselves. Upon locating them, we provide immediate care as required, and occasionally be utilised to preserve the immediate area, should the situation suggest, it may be a crime scene.

Being a HUMBSAR member is an important commitment, that cannot be taken lightly. Whilst volunteers may have busy family, work & social lives, that at times take precedence, we cannot compromise our high standards and operational capabilities. Thus, we ask all volunteers to make a commitment to attend all searches they are called for, along with training & exercises.

Although we will provide training for all our Search Technicians, Team Leaders and Search Managers, we also welcome non-operational volunteers to assist with logistics, fundraising, marketing, equipment maintenance and stores/logistics. Due to the sensitive and confidential nature of vulnerable missing persons cases all our members must have high levels of integrity. Everyone will need to pass a police background check prior to joining.
